Hong Kong – Christie's **Asian 20**th **Century & Contemporary Art** Autumn Evening Sale took place on 24 November totalling **HK\$425,250,000 / US\$54,589,216** with 73% sold by lot.

The top lot of the sale was **Zao Wou-Ki's**, **22.07.64**, which sold for HK\$115,975,000 / US\$14,887,675.

Eric Chang, Chairman, Asian 20th Century & Contemporary Art commented, "Riding on the good momentum of the New York sales week, collectors continue to respond positively to selected segments of works this evening. Exceptional results were realised for a range of Southeast Asian artists such as Lee Man Fong and Hendra Gunawan whose works achieved five times and two times above low estimate respectively. There was also strong support for works by young Chinese contemporary artists such as Hao Liang and Yuan Yuan, with Hao Liang achieving six times over low estimate and Yuan Yuan fetching HK\$1,875,000/US\$240,668 which doubled its low estimate. We expect some of these robust buying trends to continue through our day sales tomorrow, as well as in the cross-category evening sale to take place on Monday".
