Other top lots include <u>a pair of Huanghuali 'Official's Hat' Armchairs</u>, Guanmaoyi, 17th-18th Century which sold for \$118,750, <u>Sir Alfred James Munnings' 'Gorse on Ringland Hills'</u> which achieved \$87,500, and <u>a pair of George II Giltwood Dragons</u> by William Linnell, *circa* 1755, soared above the \$2,000-3,000 estimate to realize \$32,500.
