**New York** – Christie's spring auction of Prints and Multiples totaled \$11,669,625 selling 89% by lot and 93% by value. On Wednesday April 17 in the Post-War and Contemporary prints session, **Willem de Kooning's** <u>Quatre Lithographics</u> realized \$250,000 against a high estimate of \$100,000 and **Jasper Johns** <u>Usuyuki</u> realized \$231,250 against a high estimate of \$100,000. Other top performing lots were **Robert Indiana's** <u>The Book of Love</u> which realized \$162,500 against a high estimate of \$80,000 and a ten lot selection of **Andy Warhol's** <u>Sunsets</u> which sold for a combined total of \$791,250, more than doubling the combined low estimate of \$310,000.

On Thursday April 18 in the Modern Prints session, Edvard Munch's <u>Vampyr II (Vampire II)</u> from **States of Mind: Important Prints by Pablo Picasso, Edvard Munch, And Henri Matisse** realized \$507,000 against a high estimate of \$300,000 and Salvador Dalí's <u>Tête de jeune fille</u> from **The Arrogant Eye: The Collection of The Late Larry Saphire** realized \$56,250. The top lot of the auction was <u>Angst, from Album des Peintres Graveurs</u> by **Edvard Munch** which realized \$831,000. The next dedicated sale of Prints and Multiples in New York will be Contemporary Edition in July.
