The sales combined realised a total of **HK\$398,833,250 /US\$51,029,036**.

A further highlight was **A HIGHLY IMPORTANT AND EXCEEDINGLY RARE HUANGHUALI ALTAR TABLE, GONGZHUO** which realised **HK\$26,525,000/US\$3,393,762**, achieving more than four times low estimate.
