STRONG RESULTS FOR JASPER JOHNS, ANDY WARHOL, AND FRANK STELLA



New York – Christie's Prints and Multiples auction, a two-day series of sales taking place from October 22-23, collectively totaled **\$10,287,750**. The top lot of the sale was <u>Jasper Johns's *Flags I*</u> which realized **\$1,215,000**. There was global participation with bidders from 26 countries spanning five continents.

Additional strong results were achieved for <u>Andy Warhol's Double Mickey Mouse</u> that sold for **\$615,000** against a high estimate of \$300,000, and Frank Stella's *The Fountain* that realized **\$375,000**, a world auction record for the artist in the print medium.

Commenting on the Prints and Multiples auction, **Lindsay Griffith, Head of Sale,** states, "We are pleased with our results from the auction today and especially thrilled to see strong results at all parts of our market from Edvard Munch to Jasper Johns and Frank Stella."
