On 23rd and 24th November 2019, Christie's Hong Kong held five art auctions - 20th Century & Contemporary Art Evening Sale, Can't Wait 'til the Night Comes: A Masterpiece by Yoshitomo Nara, 20th Century & Contemporary Art Evening Sale, HI-LITE Evening Sale and 20th Century and Contemporary Art Morning and Afternoon Sessions which together realised a total of HK\$1,243,546,250/US\$159,727,205.

- Strong results were witnessed across the sales, with a combined sell through rate of 84% and 40% of all lots sold above high estimate
- Global buying from 20 countries


