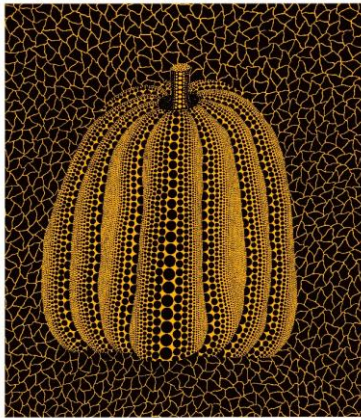

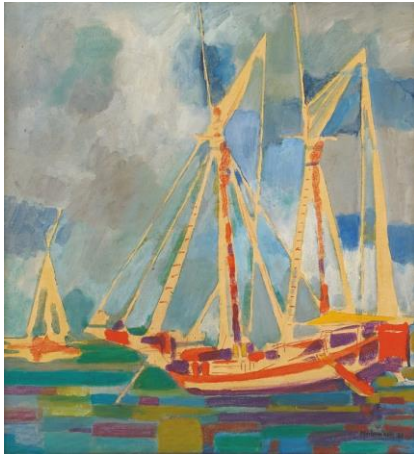

This sale is jointly curated by the Chinese Paintings & Chinese Works of Art departments to present a selection of exquisite Chinese artworks, across various media including ceramics, cloisonné, lacquer, huanghuali, aloeswood, and the finest contemporary Chinese furniture.

Headlining the auction are Important Chinese Paintings from the Wang Hsin-heng Family, a refined group of scholar's objects from the Tanglongge Collection, and a bamboo carving of a toad previously in the Wang Shixiang collection. Other noteworthy highlights include paintings by Zhang Daqian, Lin Fengmian, Li Keran, Feng Zikai.

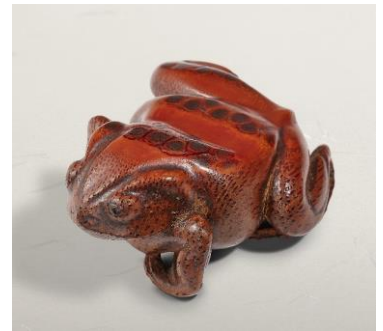
