Sale of Fine Chinese Classical Paintings and Calligraphy Surpassed its Pre-Auction High Estimate

Exceptional Results for Classical Chinese Masters

Fine Chinese Modern and Contemporary Ink Paintings Achieves a Sold Through Rate of 86%

On 8 July 2020, Christie's held two live auctions of Chinese Paintings – **Fine Chinese Classical Paintings and Calligraphy**, and **Fine Chinese Modern and Contemporary Ink Paintings**. The combined sales realized a total of **HK\$224,622,500 / US\$29,114,704**.

The top lot of the sales was *Endless Streams and Mountains* by **Wang Hui**, which achieved HK\$28,925,000 / US\$3,749,147. The results reaffirm Christie's ability in offering renowned private collections, and presenting fresh and coveted works to the market.

The Fine Chinese Classical Paintings and Calligraphy sale totaled HK\$73,187,500 / US\$9,486,282. The top lot of the sale was *Endless Streams and Mountains* by Wang Hui (pictured above), which realised HK\$28,925,000 / US\$3,749,147, achieving multiple times over its pre-sale low estimate. Another leading lot was *Study of Poems* by Huang Daozhou, which realised HK\$6,125,000 / US\$793,899, against a pre-sale estimate of HK\$500,000 / US\$64,840. The Fine Chinese Modern and Contemporary Ink Paintings sale totaled HK\$151,435,000 / US\$19,628,422 and was 86% sold by lot.
