The live sale of Prints and Multiples achieved a total of \$6,457,000, led by Pablo Picasso's Buste de femme d'après Cranach le Jeune from the Nick and Raquel Newman Collection of Linocuts by Pablo Picasso, which sold for \$687,500. Additional top lots of the sale included Andy Warhol's Campbell Soup II, which achieved \$525,000; Edvard Munch's Madonna, which realized \$375,000; and Donald Judd's Untitled, which sold for \$243,750, more than double its low estimate.

The online-only sale of Matisse on Paper: Prints & Drawings from the Estate of Jacquelyn Miller Matisse achieved a total of \$926,500, with 97% sold by lot and 100% by value. The top lot of the sale was <u>Paysage de Collioure</u>, which achieved \$162,500, more than triple its low estimate of \$50,000. Other notable results from the sale included <u>Tête penchée</u>, which realized \$112,500 against a low estimate of \$50,000; <u>La Danse</u>, which achieved \$100,000 against a low estimate of \$30,000; and <u>Le rêve de Vence</u>, which sold for \$81,250, more than double its low estimate of \$40,000.

The sale was led by *The sleep of reason produces monsters* (*El sueño de la razón produce monstruos*) *Plate 43 from: Los Caprichos*, which achieved \$81,250 — over five times its low estimate of \$15,000. Many works exceeded their estimates including *Pretty teacher* (*Linda maestral*) *Plate 68 from: Los Caprichos*, which achieved \$11,250 against a low estimate of \$4,000; *You will not escape* (*No te escaparas*) *Plate 72 from: Los Caprichos*, which realized \$10,625 against a low estimate of \$3,000; and *A bad night* (*Mala noche*) *Plate 36 from: Los Caprichos*, which sold for \$10,000, double its low estimate of \$5,000.

Additional strong results were achieved for Elegy Sketch, Skate I, which realized \$23,750 against a low estimate of \$10,000; Slate Gray Pintura, which sold for \$11,250 against a low estimate of \$2,000; and Untitled, from London Series I, which realized \$10,000 against a low estimate of \$3,000. All proceeds from the sale will benefit the Dedalus Foundation, a private nonprofit operating foundation founded by Robert Motherwell, which continues to support individuals and institutions through grants and programmatic initiatives.
