Hong Kong – On 1 and 2 December 2020, Christie's held two live auctions of Chinese Paintings – Fine Chinese Modern and Contemporary Ink Paintings and Fine Chinese Classical Paintings and Calligraphy.

The combined sales realised a total of **HK\$315,610,000 / US\$40,907,310**, with the top lots of each sale selling for multiple times over their estimates. The results demonstrate Christie's ability to offer renowned private collections and coveted works by Chinese masters.

Sale Highlights

- Both Chinese Paintings sales surpassed their pre-sale high estimates
- 62% of lots sold above high estimates across the combined sales
- The Chen Lifu Collection was 100% sold, achieving HK\$17,100,000 / US\$2,217,158, nearly tripling its pre-sale high estimate

Kim Yu, International Specialist Head of Chinese Paintings Department, commented, "The results from our sales this season are a testament to Christie's strength in selling private collections of Chinese paintings. Not only did works by master artists such as Wu Guanzhong, Fu Baoshi, Shen Zhou and Wen Zhengming perform extremely well, but a number of pieces this season achieved sale totals multiple times over their low estimates, further demonstrating Christie's ability to offer the most coveted Chinese paintings to the most distinguished collectors."

Fine Chinese Modern and Contemporary Ink Paintings

The sale totaled HK\$201,146,250 / US\$26,071,265 and was 82% sold by lot.



The top lot of the sale was *Album of Flowers, Vegetables and Objects* by **Wu Changshuo** (above), which realised **HK\$18,250,000 / US\$2,366,265**, multiple times its pre-sale low estimate.







Other highlights from the sale were *Cascading Waterfalls* by Fu Baoshi (*left*), which realised HK\$17,050,000 / US\$2,209,010, *Quiet Lake and Boats* by Wu Guanzhong (*top right*), which achieved HK\$17,050,000 / US\$2,209,010, and *Two Scholars Amongst Pine and Clouds* by Zhang Daqian (*below right*), which sold for HK\$12,250,000 / US\$1,587,765.

The Chen Lifu Collection was all sold and a notable highlight from the collection was **Returning Boat** by Fu Baoshi which realised HK\$8,650,000 / US\$1,121,545 and sold for multiple times its pre-sale low estimates.

Fine Chinese Classical Paintings and Calligraphy

The sale totaled HK\$114,463,750 / US\$14,836,045 and was 69% sold by lot.



The top lot of the sale was *Landscape and Calligraphy* by **Shen Zhou and Wen Zhengming** (above), which realised **HK\$26,650,000 / US\$3,454,199**, multiples over its pre-sale low estimate.







Notable highlights include the *Biography of Mulberry Mistletoe* by Zhu Yunming (top), which achieved HK\$11,650,000 / US\$1,509,997, *Barren Tree and Birds* by Bada Shanren (bottom left), which realised HK\$10,090,000 / US\$1,307,800, *Poem in Running-Cursive Script* by Wang Duo (bottom right), which sold for HK\$6,250,000 / US\$810,084 and *Second Ode to the Red Cliff* by Wen Zhengming, which realised HK\$5,250,000 / US\$680,471.
