The top lot of the sale was an iconic <u>Patek Philippe Nautilus reference 3700</u> in yellow gold that sold for \$150,000. Other notable results included an impressive diamond-set <u>Richard Mille RM007</u> which achieved \$100,000; and a <u>Patek Philippe Chronograph reference 5070J</u> that sold for \$62,500.
